## NOW IS THE TIME

While a combination of private funding commitments and funding included in the bond issue passed in November 2019 will address a portion of the stadium project, we still need your help creating elite facilities for all of our student-athletes and community. Phase II of the stadium project, which includes home and visitor fieldhouses, will be entirely privately funded. We also continue to fundraise for the natatorium, and baseball and softball fields.

The time is right to act! Sycamore Community Schools is going through major facility changes thanks to the support of our bond issue, including moving Sycamore Stadium to the high school campus for the first time in school history.

## A CRITICAL NEED

The district has a unique opportunity to make changes that will leave a legacy of greatness and impact future generations.

The district has conducted extensive assessments of our facilities including renovations and potential replacement of our aging athletic venues. Thanks to community's support, the stadium project was partially funded through the bond issue passed in 2019.

The Sycamore Board of Education is committed to privately fundraising the rest of the funds needed to complete the stadium, the natatorium, and baseball and softball fields. We intend to raise \$7 million to build these elite facilities. With your contribution, our district will provide environments that will help our Aviators take flight.




