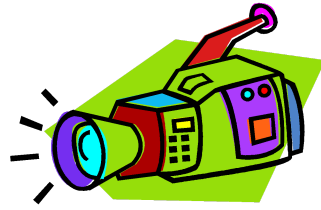


FLAG FOOTBALL

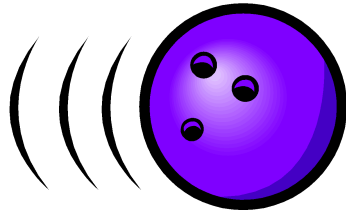
MATH & SCIENCE CONFERENCE
