GRADES 5-6 SUMMER LEARNING AND ENRICHMENT

Program Information

Sycamore Community Schools' 5-6 Summer Learning and Enrichment begins on June 10 and concludes on July 3. There will be no class on June 19. Classes will be held at the Sycamore Junior High School.

Greene 101 is a 1-day transition program. Session 1 - Tuesday, August 6 (8 am - 2 pm) **OR** Session 2 - Wednesday, August 7 (8 am - 2 pm). Greene 101 will be held at the E.H. Greene School, 5200 Aldine Dr. **This program is offered to incoming 5th graders.** Transportation is **NOT** available.

Enrolling a Student

Enrollment must be completed online. "Final Forms" will be utilized for emergency information. If Final Forms is not up-to-date, parents must print out, complete, and return the Emergency Medical Authorization Form.

Transportation

Transportation **is** available for "Summer Learning and Enrichment". Students who need transportation to Summer Learning and Enrichment **must complete and submit the "Online Summer School Transportation Request" form by May 24**. Transportation is **NOT** available for Greene 101. Please be aware that those requesting transportation are committing to riding the bus. K-12 students will ride the same bus.

Fees

- The fee for intervention/remedial courses is \$150.
- The fee for Accelerated Math Summer Support is \$125
- The fee for Greene 101 is \$50.
- Fees are waived for students who qualify for the Federal Free and Reduced Price Meals program.
- A 100% refund, minus a \$20 processing fee, will be granted for cancellations made before the first day of class.
- A 75% refund, minus a \$20 processing fee, will be granted for cancellations made 1-5 days after the first class.
- A 50% refund, minus a \$20 processing fee, will be granted for cancellations made 6-10 days after the first day of class.
- No refunds can be made for cancellations made more than 10 days after the first day of class.
- Courses that do not have sufficient enrollment will be canceled and fees will be returned.

Course Name	Current Grade	Hours
<p>Mathematics Exploration This course is designed to help review and brush up on math concepts such as fractions, decimals, and integers while gaining math confidence. (\$150)</p>	5-6	10 am - 12 pm
<p>Summer Reading Workshop This course will focus on the development of reading, writing, and vocabulary skills. (\$150)</p>	5-6	8 am -10 pm
<p>Greene 101 Greene 101 is a unique opportunity designed to help incoming 5th-grade students develop the skills necessary for success at E.H. Greene. A team of teachers will conduct activities that strengthen organization, study skills, team-building, collaboration, problem-solving, and technological and critical thinking skills. Students will spend the first half of each session building the skills necessary to become a more independent, structured, and responsible learner. The second half of each session will be devoted to team building, social skills, and things specific to the Greene School. With students coming from four different elementary schools, we hope this experience will ease the fears that are typical when coming to Greene. (\$50.00) There is NO district provided transportation for Greene 101. <p>Accelerated Math Summer Support (By invitation only) Students who participate in accelerated math in 5th - 8th grade skip an entire grade level of content and curriculum. For students moving to an accelerated class, this <i>virtual</i> summer support will provide weekly; mini-lessons reinforcing grade-level content that will be skipped, optional enrichment opportunities for students to practice skills to build computational and problem-solving skills and strengthen mathematical habits and behaviors; and office hours for students to ask questions and receive individualized support for skipped grade-level content. <i>This course is not a prerequisite to participate in accelerated math in the 2024 - 2025 school year.</i> (\$125)</p> <p><u>Important Information to Consider:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Any exiting 5th - 8th-grade student entering a new accelerated math class is invited to participate in this <i>optional</i> virtual summer support. REGISTERING FOR SUMMER LEARNING AND ENRICHMENT

- Beginning April 15, Summer Learning registration, fee payment, and the Transportation Request Form can be completed online through **Parent Portal**.
- Parents who already have a Parent Portal account can register their students for Summer Learning by visiting www.sycamoreschools.org and clicking "**Parent Portal**".
- Parents without a Parent Portal account will need to create one to register online. To create a Parent Portal account, visit www.sycamoreschools.org and click on the Parent Portal "create an account" link.
- Once inside the Parent Portal click "**Online Fees**".
- Select the student and click "**Click Here to Pay Fees**". A new screen will appear. Click the "**Summer School Sign Up**" button.
- To register for Summer School, click the button for the appropriate grade level.
- Next, check the boxes next to the course name(s) in which the student will enroll.
- Click the "**Add to Shopping Cart**" button.
- To register more than one student, click the "Continue Shopping" button and repeat the steps.
- Once all students and courses are added, click the "**Check Out**" button, enter payment information and click "Pay Now." Follow the prompts to pay.
- Once your payment is completed, you will see a payment confirmation screen; this screen will have the link to the **online** Transportation Request form. **If you need transportation, you MUST complete and submit this online form.**
