Custodial	\$45/hour, Monday-Saturday (charged when an event is scheduled after normal work hours) \$55/hour, Sundays and holidays (charged when an event is scheduled on Sunday and/or holidays)	
Kitchen	\$30/hour (charged when an event is scheduled using district kitchen facilities)	
Security	\$75/hour (required when the expected attendance is 100 people or more. Two hour minimum.)	
Theater Technician	\$20/hour (charged when an event is scheduled at a district theater)	
Theater Manager	\$55/hour (charged when an event is scheduled at a district theater and is required by the school)	
Natatorium supervisor	\$45/hour (charged when designated by the school/facility)	
Lifeguards	\$12/hour (charged when an event is scheduled and the group does not provide lifeguards. Red Cross certified lifeguards must be present during all swimming).	

*Advance deposits may be charged at the discretion of the district. Groups requesting use of district facilities may appeal fees by submitting a letter to the Superintendent prior to use of the facility. Group I includes groups with non-profit status with the IRS and with at least 51 percent of participants living in Sycamore Community Schools. Group II includes groups which do not meet the IRS definition of a non-profit and any group (for-profit or non-profit) with less than 51 percent of participants living in Sycamore Community Schools.
