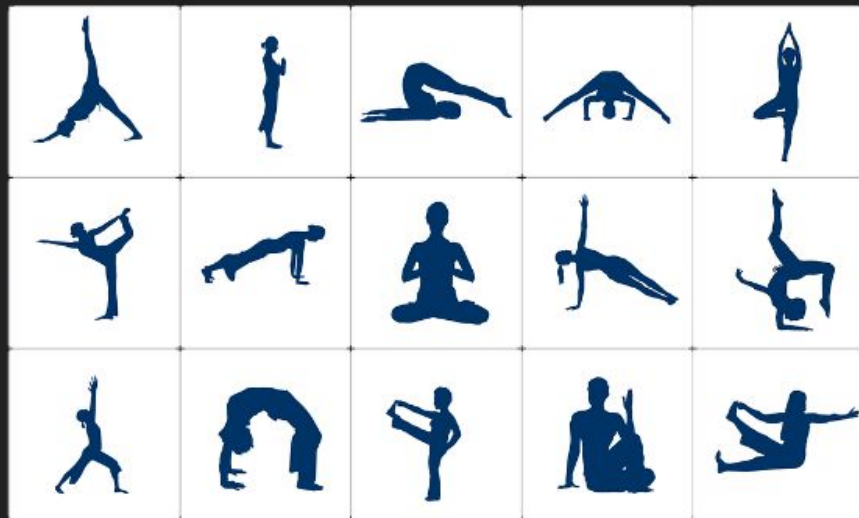

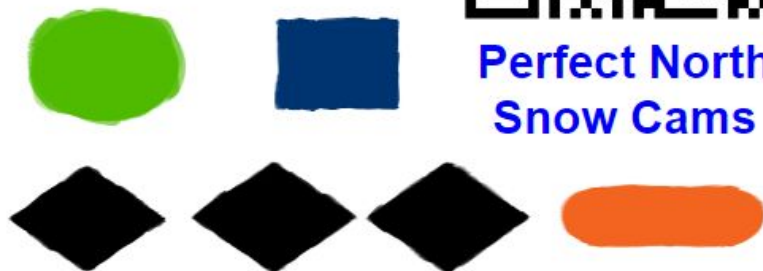

Join the Daikaiju Arts and Cinema Club!

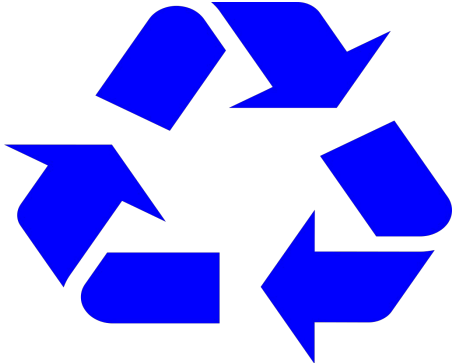

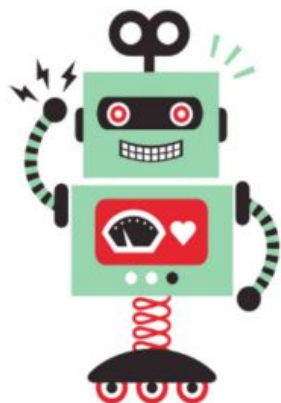
